Minutes of meeting held 09/02/18

Frances welcomed all to the meeting and all introduced themselves.

There were apologies from Children's Centre and Home start

Attending:

Fran Taylor- BBC, Richard Tory- BBL, Anna Kusztyb- LCHS, Diane Swift –LCHS, Sue Silvester – LCHS, Lauren Williams – Transported, Diane Johnson – Boston Mayflower, Stephanie Goodale – GMLC, Holly Maidens – BUFCCF.

Event days set at 16th and 17th August 10am – 3pm

Each organisation confirmed what activity they would bring to the event:

Mayflower Housing – Would deliver both art and craft areas offering two different crafts a day. Mayflower will pay for all art and craft materials thus saving this amount being paid from the budget.

Mayflower Housing would also oversee vehicle management on the site.

Frances confirmed that free parking would be offered in Tunnard Street car park, she requested that all let her have the car model, colour and registration so car park passes would be available.

Boston United Football Club Community Foundation – Holly confirmed that they would deliver a mix of fun sports as previous years.

GMLC – Steph confirmed that the opportunity to learn CPR would be one of their activities along with fun games. This station would also be the first aid and lost child post.

Lincolnshire Community Health Services – Anna confirmed that they would bring lots of information and give advice on Safety in the Sun and knowledge on how to register with a GP.

Boston Big Local – Funders for the event – Members from BBL will network with the community to seek information on what the community would like to see in Boston.

They would also provide flags for Children to colour.

Free ice creams will be given to those completing the questionnaire for BBL. This year these will be paid for from the funding already in place as a saving of £500 has been made by not having to purchase the art and craft materials.

There are some buckets and spades and Frisbees left from last year, Richard will see how many and report back at next meeting.

Transported – Lauren – To be confirmed but hopefully Rhubarb Theatre will deliver two productions on one day and Transported will deliver more art and craft the next day.

Homestart – BBC Pop-Up

Children’s Centre – BBC Pop-Up

Fran continued to say that she is looking to organise 3 themed afternoons on the beach area. The beach will be closed for these events:

13th August – Golden Oldies – 2pm -4pm – For elderly people from the community. The 78 DJ will play songs from the 40’s and 50’s, song sheets available for a good old sing song and various games.

21st August – Fun on the Beach – 2pm -4pm – Afternoon for those living with learning difficulties and disabled persons. Fun games will be available – treasure hunt in the sand, boules, target throw, sand art and sandcastle building and games.

28th August – Back in Time – 2pm -4pm – Afternoon for those living with Dementia and their carer. The 78 DJ will play songs from the 40’s and 50’s, song sheets available for a good old sing song and various games – I spy bottle, Beach ball question memory game.

Fran has requested that BBL look at these events as bolt on’s to the beach events.

Fran was requested by Richard BBL to send in all the information so it can be discussed at their next meeting.

The next meeting was booked for Friday 27th April 2018 – Geoff Moulder Leisure Pool, Rowley Road, Boston at 10am

There was no other business and the meeting finished at 11am.


