Administration and Scheme Overview

- All monies from both Theme 3.1.1 and 3.1.2 were assigned and have been paid out to the groups.

Events Held in Q4:

- Boston United Community Foundation's Football Unites Community Day took place on Saturday 30th March 2019 to coincide with Boston United's game with Curzon Ashton. LCVS's Area Officer attended the event and felt that it was a well-organised and well-attended event with families taking part in a variety of football related activities during it.
- The event culminated in a 4-1 victory for Boston United and the highest attendance for a home game this season.
