League rules require clubs to have a specific kit, we are pleased to help Boston Netball Club purchase their club kit which will also display our logo.

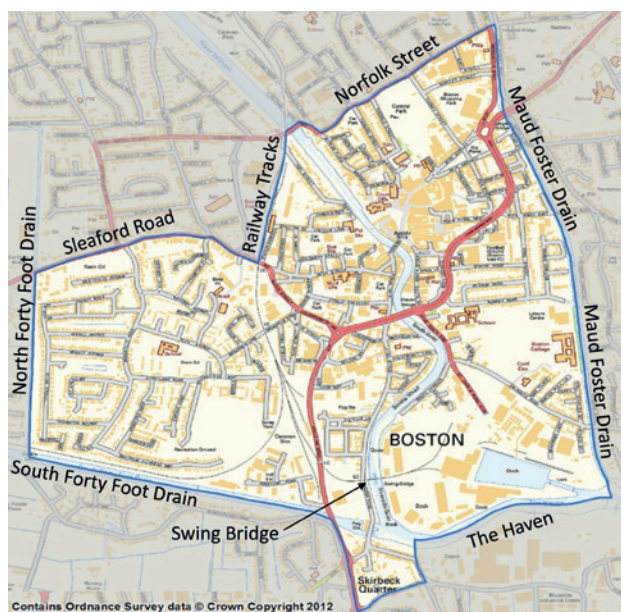

Following the completion of the Broadfield Lane Green Space, we have now funded equipment for three of the playgrounds in the Boston Big Local area, with the fourth being funded later in the year.

The installation of the swings, climbing frame and zip wire cost £28,292.99 (ex VAT). Of which BBL funded £26,292.99

with BTAC funding £2000.

In line with our theme of 'Creating a more attractive environment', with the priority to 'Improve local amenities and open spaces in Boston Big Local Area', we are really proud of the difference we have made for the children and families who live in the BBL area.

# Monopoly Update

Following a very successful launch of the Boston Monopoly on the 11th December 2021, nearly all the copies were sold before new year.

If you have not yet got your board game, please don't worry because we are looking into the possibility placing another

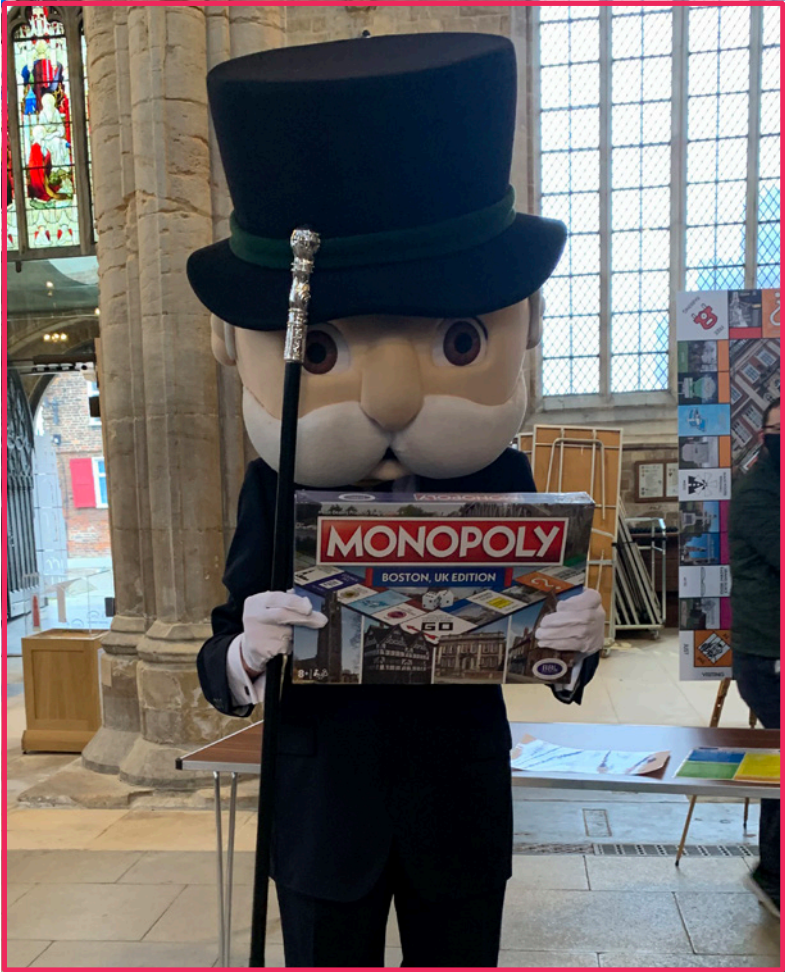
order run.

The Hasbro branded Boston Monopoly game was 80% funded by Boston Big Local and 20% by Boston Borough Council's Empowering Healthy Communities fund. This means that we invested £33,950 and the council £7,000.

A total of £40,950 was invested

into making the games, after they had all been sold a total of £44,514 had been invested into good causes in the area.

The 1500 boards were sold for £30 each, with good causes keeping the whole sale price. See below to see who and how much we have supported groups with links to the Boston Big Local area.

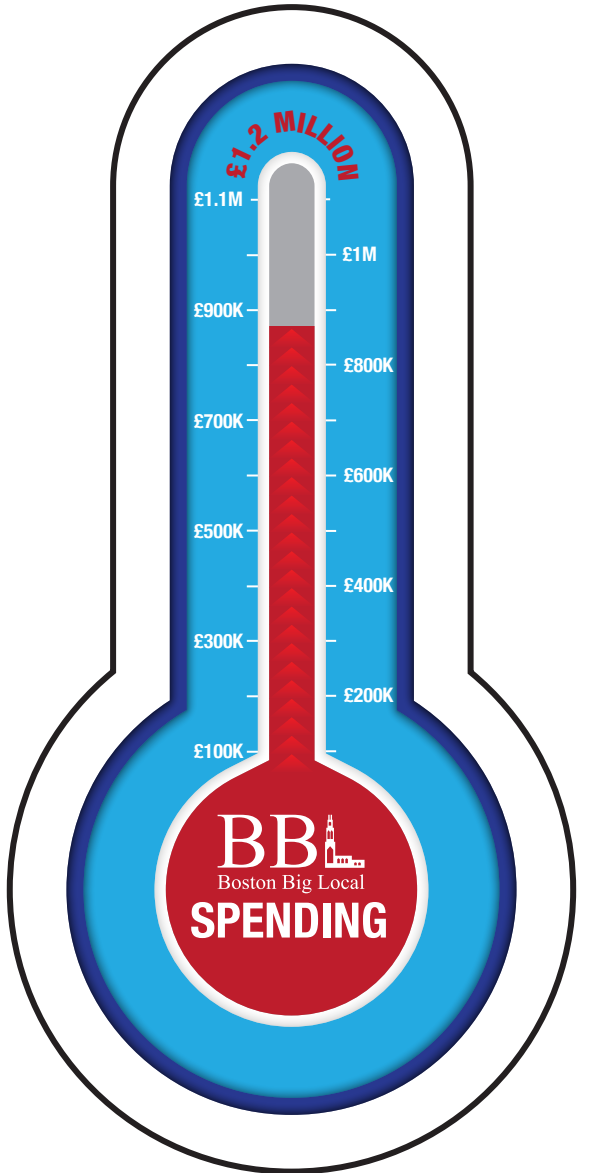
