We have continued carving the Hesperus, and Dereck has made a good job of carving and embellishing his work with heat and oil.

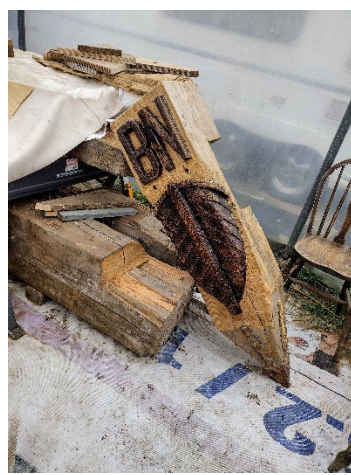
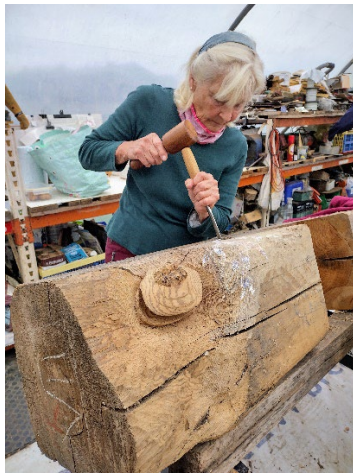
Sandrae has continued carving the shell with barnacles and is now finishing it all with a large whelk shell.
