After several months following Boston Borough Council tender and procurement process a provider was awarded the contract for improvements for four play areas in Boston which are Central Park, Woodville Road, St John's Park and Garfits Lane.

The provider is Kompan and with over £150,000 of works to be completed Boston can look forward to seeing some exciting new play opportunities.

The work on the four play sites will start with Central Park on 17th July in the hope that this site will be completed by the start of the school summer holidays. New equipment will be a Little mermaid and Ugly Duckling unit, a four way springer water lily, a large horse springer, newly laid turf area complete with picnic tables and new seating.

Next will see a new Pirate Ship installed in Woodville Road.

Then the three part ship in St John's Park


And finally two new Table Tennis Tables in Garfit's Lane.
