After several months following Boston Borough Council tender and procurement process a provider was awarded the contract for improvements for four play areas in Boston which are Central Park, Woodville Road, St John's Park and Garfits Lane.

The provider is Kompan and with over £150,000 of works to be completed Boston can look forward to seeing some exciting new play opportunities.

Work commenced on July 17th in Central Park and over the next two weeks all sites were under construction.

Unfortunately weather condition hampered work and there were days where work was stopped.

However all works were completed by the middle of August.

Children and young people were very keen for the work to be completed so they could gain access to the new equipment in St John's play area.
